Course Overview

This course trains students how to write essays at a university level. It focuses on methods of organization, analysis, research skills, and the production of short expository and research essays. Students will also practice reading skills, and the conventions of academic writing.

- 2. learning how to use writing aids, such as handbooks, dictionaries, and online resources;

- 4. presenting ideas effectively and formally within a scholastic environment
- 5. engaging in academic communication in a coherent, organized, and well-structured manner.
